Some children are playing in the country where everything began. They want to discover the world by transforming their universe. They imitate their elders with audacity and self-confidence. They dare to love without knowing what it really means. They even dare to argue before finding the word "hate" in their pockets. They know about smells, skin, caresses, neglect, shelter, desire. They don't know about time. And all of a sudden, more than sixty years have gone by.

And now, having grown old, multiple words fall from their pockets like shriveled leaves. They know about smells, skin, caresses, neglect, shelter, desire. And paradoxically, they don't refrain from arguing when they know the real meaning of love. They know about time. What they don't know is that love always gives us a chance.

Amour makes us reflect about the thin line that exists between disaffection and unconditional love. It is an ode to putting aside our differences, a call to liberating ourselves from our prejudices.

The theatrical proposals of the Basque company Marie de Jongh, founded in 2008, are geared at families. Their work is completely gestural, without words, creating children's theatre for adults, and adult theatre for children. Since the beginning, they have been very successful, and are currently one of the companies of reference for the performing arts in and outside Spain.
