

Three stories are intertwined to tell a crime born of despair and heartbreak. Three characters interpreted by a single actress bear the brunt of this police story which includes songs as a narrative instrument. Alicia Rafaela kills her husband, fed up of his abuse and his violence. A character full of humility and innocence facing an extreme situation: how can she manage? Alma, in her world of wealth and superficiality, hits rock bottom, reaching the limits of instability and insanity. An





evening radio programme called *Música de fiambrería*, provides support and listens to those who need to be heard. The presenter of the programme, a bizzare, solitary character, opens the microphone to the dialogue of these lives from an absurd and tragicomic location.

*Música de fiambrería* speaks of the universal topics of love, its absence, its excess and its failure, told from a female point of view; about life and its fleeting passage, questioning our place in life depending on the adversity of fate.
