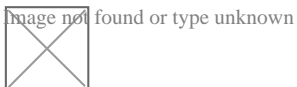

Three stories are intertwined to tell a crime born of despair and heartbreak. Three characters interpreted by a single actress bear the brunt of this police story which includes songs as a narrative instrument. Alicia Rafaela kills her husband, fed up of his abuse and his violence. A character full of humility and innocence facing an extreme situation: how can she manage? Alma, in her world of wealth and superficiality, hits rock bottom, reaching the limits of instability and insanity. An





evening radio programme called *Música de fiambrería*, provides support and listens to those who need to be heard. The presenter of the programme, a bizzare, solitary character, opens the microphone to the dialogue of these lives from an absurd and tragicomic location.

Música de fiambrería speaks of the universal topics of love, its absence, its excess and its failure, told from a female point of view; about life and its fleeting passage, questioning our place in life depending on the adversity of fate.
