

Tragicomedy that starts with the search for the bones of Miguel de Cervantes at the Convento de las Trinitarias Descalzas in Madrid. It is the year 2015 of our era. Cervantes, awoken by the noise of pics and shovels, is disoriented, always in search of the glory he did not achieve in life. The ups and downs of a difficult life, sustained by failure, have made him a sad, envious, suspicious and conceited man, yet also noble, sincere and human, who passes aimlessly through the scenes of a *Don Quijote* who does not know what he has written. And he begins searching for himself, with the world, his contemporaries, god, prison, love, war and his arm (which is not as dead as it seems), wanting to show that you do not fall unless you are pushed, and to

demonstrate that he is a great artist, the greatest of authors, that the world makes mistakes, that all others are worse than he is, that everything he touches can become a success, that life is always something else. But no...or perhaps yes. Euroscena is the result of more than forty years of work and constant renovation, during the company's team has always been at the forefront of theatrical production.
