# TEATRO CERVANTES | ECHEGARAY DE MÁLAGA

In this new show, Manuel Lombo pays tribute to Manuel Alejandro, born in Jerez and one of the greatest Spanish language composers, to his colossal hits and to the singers who made them popular.

With elegant staging and a varied range of styles and sounds, this vision of the work of one of the most important composers in Spain will be a source of delight for all those who feel popular music in all its greatness.

Manuel Lombo is a singer, songwriter, composer and performer of music that is full of flamenco connotations, with beautiful and realistic nuances and poetry, who moves brilliantly through all kinds of styles. He has the heterodoxy of a young classic, the respect of an avant-garde flamenco singer, and the volcanic strength of someone who loves his land.

The pianist, performer and composer from Jerez Chico Pérez is one of the musicians of the present-day flamenco scene with the greatest impact. Winner of the Award for Best Artist from the RTVE Institute, Young Talent Award and 2018 Composer Award, amongst others, his debut album *Gruserías* was one of the best flamenco records in 2019, according to the newspaper *El País*, being nominated Best Flamenco Album for the MIN Awards. He has shared the stage with renown artists such as Diego Amador, Israel Fernández, Farruquito, Arcángel and Sandra Carrasco.
