Maestrissimo is an *allegro e molto vivace* show, half way between a chamber music concert, satirical comedy and the portrait of a period, which shows, in sheer Yllana style, the adventures and misadventures of a string quartet at some undetermined time between the 17th and 18th centuries (Baroque and Neoclassicism).

A back up musician, a nameless third string with huge talent seeks to rise in the hierarchy and achieve the title of *maestrissimo*. Will his talent and genius be sufficient to make a name for himself in such a hierarchical world? Will he achieve the prestige which he rightfully deserves?

Along the same line as the show *Pagagnini*, but with its own identity, *Maestrissimo* addresses topics such as ethics, creation, originality and the value of art in society.
