He has travelled all over the world with the companies of Javier Barón, Paco Peña and Cristina Hoyos, and has collaborated with Carlos Saura, Vicente Amigo, Pepe de Lucía, José Mercé, Alejandro Sanz, Miguel Poveda and Pasión Vega. He has won the 2016 Bandera de Andalucía award, the 6th El Suplemento Best Album Award for Denominación de origen and the Manolo Caracol and Camarón Awards at the 18th National Flamenco Singing Competition of Cordoba.
